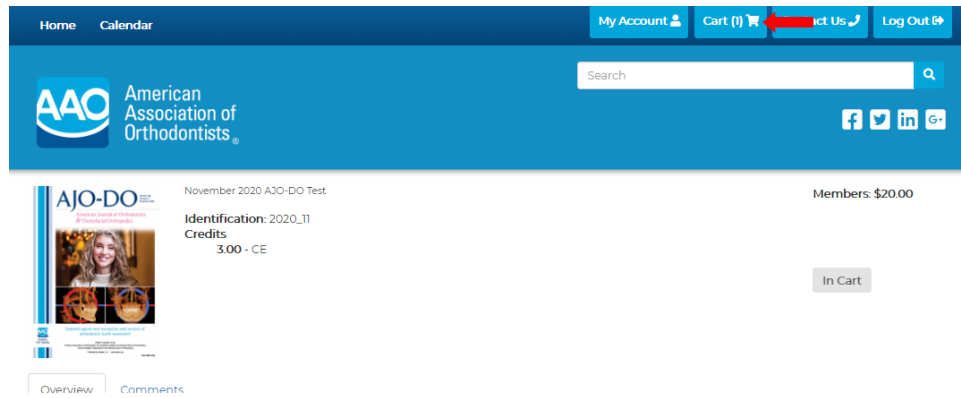

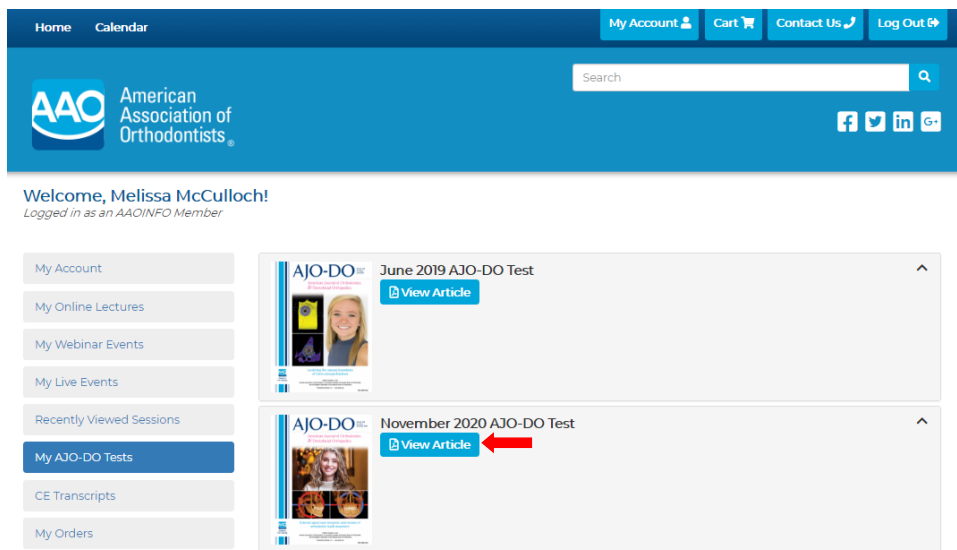

- *3) The authors reported that after maxillary incisor retraction in patients with Class II Division 1 malocclusion, the changes in soft tissue were dissimilar to patients with a skeletal Class I relationship. (True/False)
- *4) The authors concluded that patients with a Class II Division 1 malocclusion showed a significant decrease in lip strain, lower lip thickness, lower lip length, and nasolabial angle after treatment with maxillary 2 premolar extraction. (True/False)
